Your ward has already stepped ahead from the Pre Primary level to the Primary level of learning.

A Progressive learning programme has been designed for junior classes to be followed by students and teachers in an entirely stress free and enjoyable environment. Efforts are being made to nurture latent abilities of each child.

The assessment disciplines include a practical learning system comprising of social values, the classroom conduct, the accent the child picks up and how to boost the level of confidence to present oneself very smartly in all situations.

A programme has been designed for strengthening writing ability of students, emphasizing upon written expression, retention power and learning to complete the task within a specified time. Under the programme students will be assessed regularly, twice in each of the two rounds of Appraisals, for specified subjects in a short span of 30 to 40 minutes on the basis of what they have learnt within a period of a month or at the most two months. A questionnaire will be provided to students wherein they will "ATTEMPT" the questions.

A comprehensive report of assessment of each student's performance will be handed over to parents twice in a year. All activities whether scholastic, non- scholastic, sports, arts, outings, communication skills and the regular classes and home assignments will help us to assess the day to day performance of students in different aspects as well as ensuring regular learning by each student.
