- Give your child 'One task a day' everyday like watering plants, putting their toys in place, filling water bottles etc, under your guidance.


We wish you and your child a very happy summer holiday. It's time to enjoy and create a bond with family, friends and relatives.

To utilize this time in the most constructive way we have prepared some fun-filled worksheets to reinforce the concepts done so far in class.




