APRIL- MAY'25

Chapter 1: Numbers: Ex 1A to 1 G

Fun with Maths Activity: The spike-abacus making: It represents the number of multi-digits where the digits are represented by the spikes of the abacus.

The spikes from right to left represent the places of the place values of the digits in increasing order i.e., 1, 10, 100,1000 etc. In the given grid numbers up to 6/7 digits are given, their place value is written in jumbled order. Children have to search them horizontally, vertically and diagonally and write their number name while putting them in the proper order of their respective place values.

Chapter 2: Roman Numerals: Ex : 2a and b

Fun with Maths Activity :

Chapter 9 : Profit Loss : Ex 9A to 9 C :

Fun with Math Activity:

Students track the costs of production for the toy. They then demonstrate the toy and take orders from their classmates. Using the number of orders (quantity demanded), students calculate their total revenue and then either their profit or loss.

NOVEMBER '2025 :

Chapter 10 : Simple Interest : Ex 2 A and B

Fun with Math Activity: Matching Board Game: Students will calculate the interest values using the simple interest equation and then match the answer to the principal, time, and rate options.

Chapter 11: Measurements: Ex: 3 A and B

Fun with Math Activity: One of the best measurement activities examples in daily life is cooking. When kids get involved in baking or cooking, they naturally engage with measurements. By using measuring cups and spoons, they learn about volume and [quantity](#). It's a delicious way to understand measurements and enjoy the results!

DECEMBER '2025 : Chapter 12 : Perimeter ,Area and Volume : Ex :12 A to D

1. **Fun with Math Activity:** Nature Walk: Take the class on a nature walk and ask them to identify and measure different natural objects, such as leaves, rocks, and tree trunks. Then, have them calculate the area and perimeter of these objects using the appropriate formulas and compare their answers with their classmates.

2. Chalk Shapes: Have the class work in pairs to draw and label different shapes on the pavement using chalk. Then, have each pair measure the length and width of each shape and use this measurement to calculate the perimeter and area of the shape. Finally, have each pair share their answers with the class.

Chapter 13 : Time : Ex: 13 A ,B and C

Fun with Math Activity: Use our *Time Dominoes* in small groups or as a whole class activity. Students need to match the correct analogue time with its digital version.

This domino activity is also available in five-minute intervals.

Fun with Math Activity: Creating Art with Angles Activity, students will make a spectacular design with circles and then draw their angles. All you need is a compass (or circular shapes to trace), a ruler, a protractor, and a choice of coloring tools. Students will measure and color code angles based on

classification, creating unique patterns while revising their learning of different angles.
